Achieving the Supplier Sustainability goals outlined in the SHA will become a requirement for Supplier Gold Certification, which offers critical advantages to suppliers. Providing a competitive advantage to sustainable suppliers rewards existing good behavior while incentivizing others to join our journey to a healthier planet.
